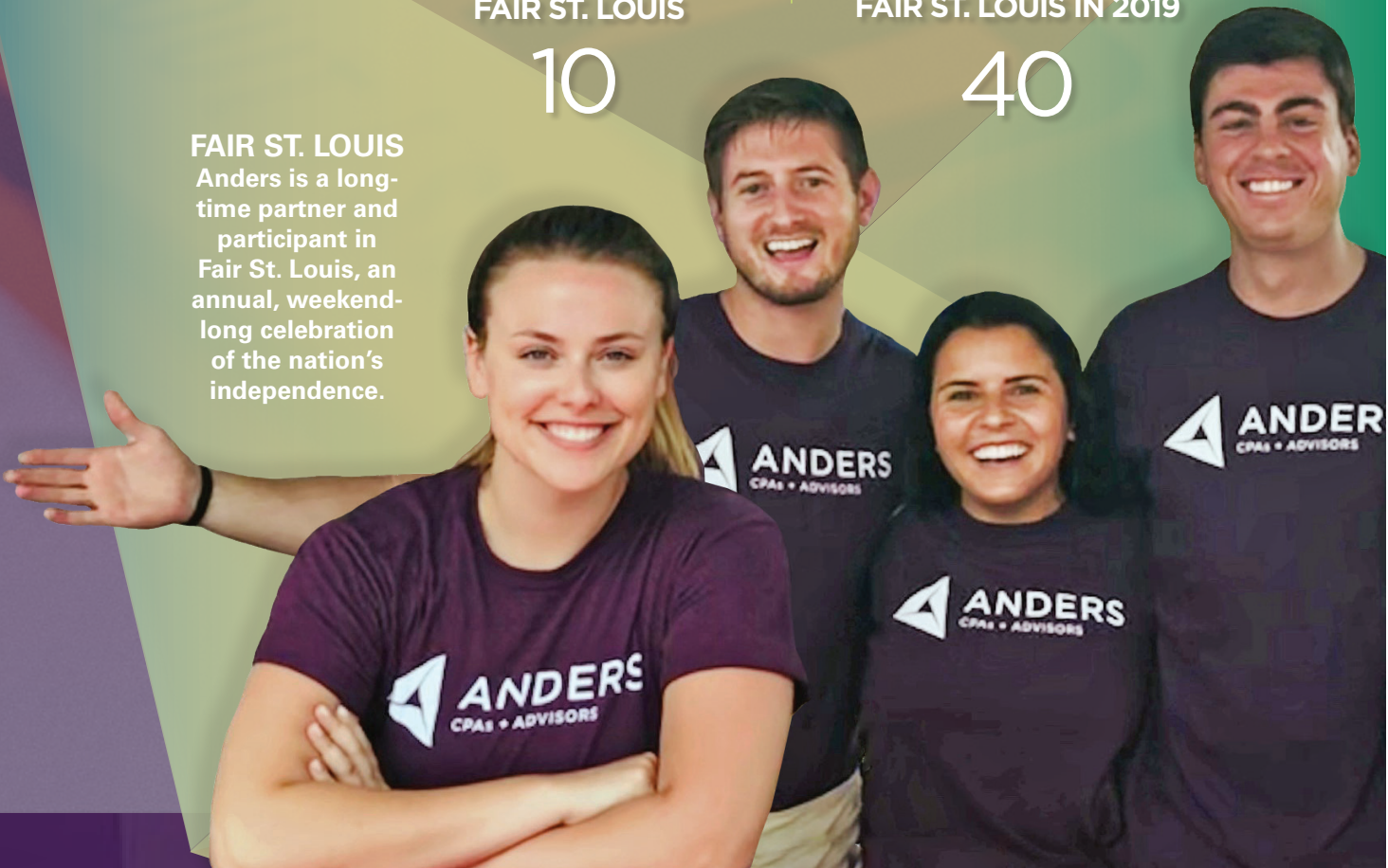

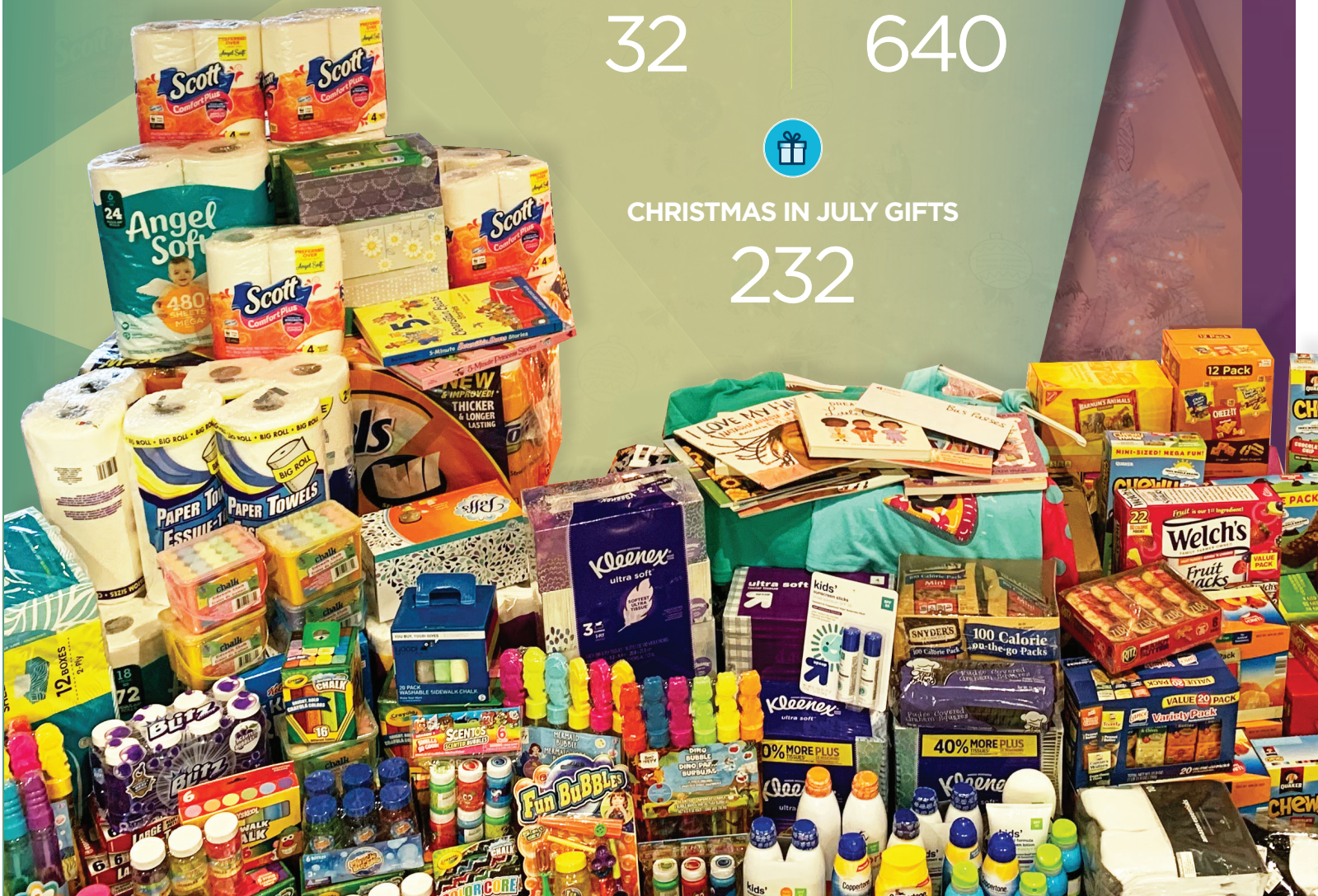

WHAT IS HOOPS FOR HOPE?

Hoops for Hope is a NCAA basketball pool and the firm's flagship fundraiser. Each year, it draws participation from clients, colleagues, referral sources and friends of the firm from all over the United States.
